Evacuation Levels

LEVEL 1 READY

- Means “BE READY” for potential evacuation
- 5Ps: People | Pets | Pills | Photos | Papers

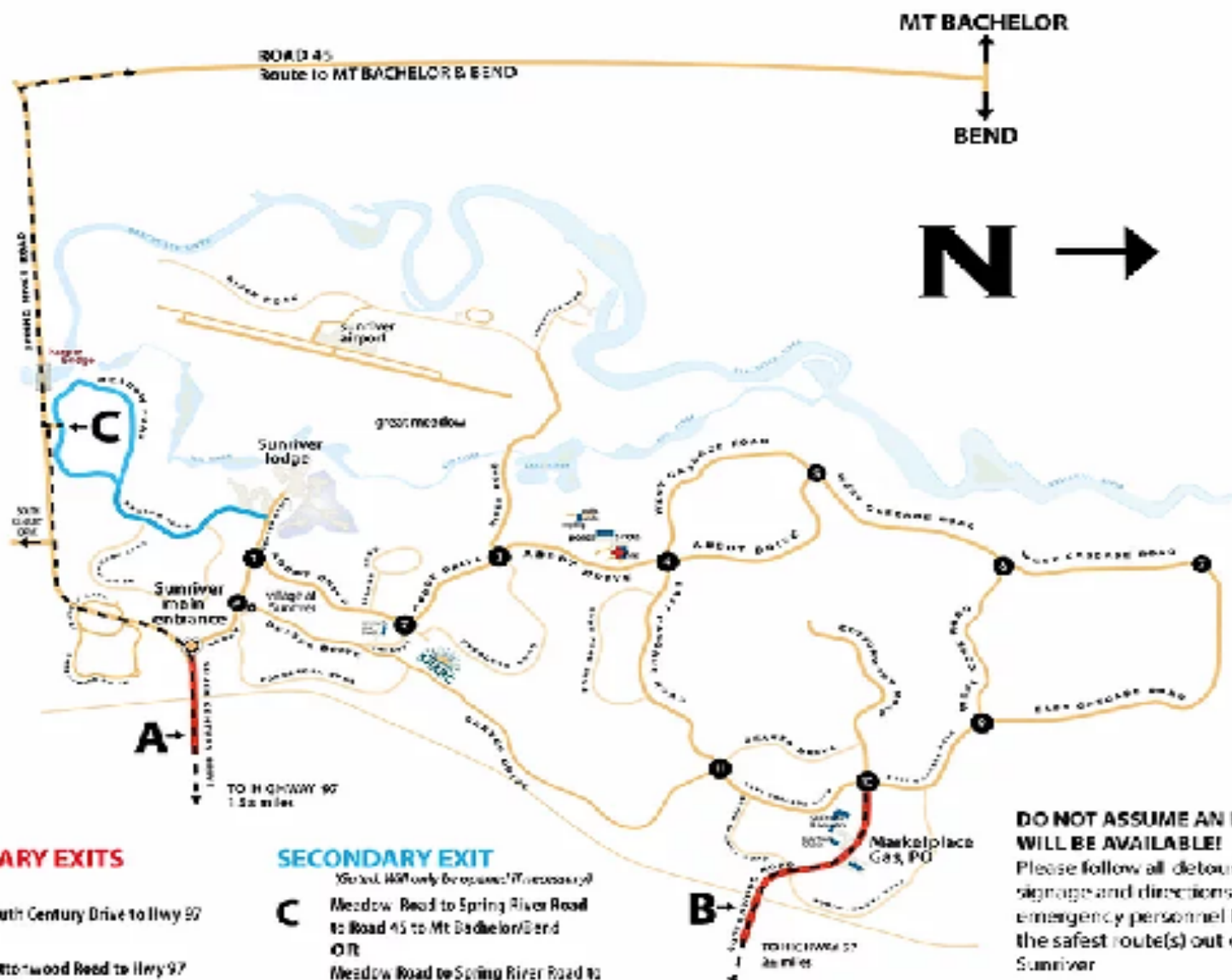
LEVEL 2 SET

- Means “BE SET” to evacuate
- You must prepare to leave at a moment’s notice
- Load your 5Ps and go-bag into the car

LEVEL 3 GO!

- Means “GO” evacuate now, Leave immediately!
- Danger to your area is current or imminent
- This will be the last notice you will receive

SUNRIVER EVACUATION MAP



PRIMARY EXITS

- A** South Century Drive to Hwy 97
- B** Cottonwood Road to Hwy 97

SECONDARY EXIT

- (Noted, WSP only to be used if necessary)*
- C** Meadow Road to Spring River Road to Road 45 to Mt Bachelor/Bend OR Meadow Road to Spring River Road to South Century Drive to Hwy 97

DO NOT ASSUME AN EXIT WILL BE AVAILABLE!
